**ARTS TOPICS I (Ages 5 ½ -9):** Learn basic elements of art, such as: lines, shapes, symmetry, colors, values, overlaps. Class projects include drawing, painting, printing, ceramics, mosaics, stained glass, crafts and more.

**PAINTING & DRAWING (Ages 5 ½ - 9):** Learn the basics of drawing, painting, coloring and printing. Develop art skills and creativity. Work with pastels, watercolors, acrylics and more.

**PAINTING & DRAWING (Ages 9 +):** Age appropriate – incorporates the basics of drawing, painting, coloring, printing, and mural design. Develop art skills and creativity. Work with pastels, watercolors, acrylics and more.

**CERAMICS: (5 ½-9 and 9+)**

Instruction in clay molding to build original sculptures. Explore printing, under glazing, and dipping techniques to create finished ceramic pieces.



**POTTERY (9+):** Class offers instruction in basic hand building techniques through use of pinch, coil, slabs, drape molds, and will include wheel throwing.

**CARTOONING WITH AL BIGLEY (9+):** Comics and Cartooning. Al has worked on various well-known comics since the 1980's, including Marvel's "Ironman", DC's "The Fly", and Archie Comics "Sonic the Hedgehog".
